

Cross Country Committee

The Cross Country Committee has met once since the last SACC meeting. Discussions have continued on the need to attract more scrutineers into cross country disciplines, and the different engineering that they see with some of our vehicles. Additionally there have been further discussions about the technical compliance of some of the factory standard UTVs particularly with regard to firewalls. We do not believe that this is a current problem for competitors in Scotland.

There was also a discussion about standards for winches and winch hardware being used in challenge events. This topic is likely to be considered further at a future meeting.

The British Cross Country Championship appears to be seeing a resurgence of interest from Competitors. In previous years they have held a number of rounds in Wales, but with the changes in the relationship/costs with Natural Resources Wales they are looking at other options, both in England and Scotland. Currently there is one round held in Scotland, in Dumfries and Galloway.
